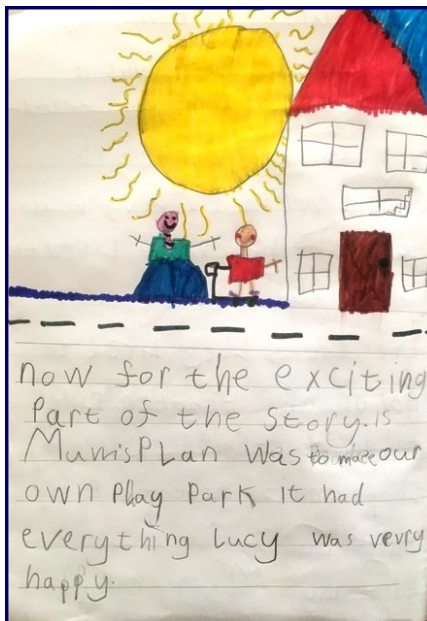
News of the Week By Lachlan
